IIF Booth at GIFA CAIRO 2025

The Institute of Indian Foundrymen (IIF), under the aegis of National Center of Export Promotion, participated at GIFA Middle East Africa (GIFA CAIRO) 2025 held from 6–8 September 2025 at the Egypt International Exhibition Center, Cairo with a 12 sq m booth, providing a dedicated space to showcase India's foundry industry capabilities.

The GIFA Cairo 2025 event brought together industry leaders, decision-makers, and technology providers from across the Middle East and North Africa (MENA). For India, this platform was strategically important to explore opportunities in a market valued at over USD 10 billion, with strong growth expected in automotive, construction, and oil & gas sectors.

Delegates interacted with decision-makers and buyers from over 12 MENA countries, with strong participation from Saudi Arabia, UAE, Turkey, and Egypt. The exhibition showcased Egypt's emergence as a regional manufacturing hub.

There were around 80 visitors to the IIF Booth. They collected the catalogues at Display and also downloaded list of companies who wanted to be associated with MENA market.

Indian Delegation & B2B Engagements

IIFF also organized a delegation to GIFA & METEC Middle East Africa 2025, from 5th to 10th September, 2025. The visit provided a crucial platform for Indian foundries to engage with stakeholders across the MENA region, strengthen bilateral trade opportunities, and establish long-term collaborations. The mission culminated in the signing of a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the Chamber of Metallurgical Industries, Federation of Egyptian Industries, Cairo, Egypt.

The IIF delegation comprised 18 Companies representing leading Indian foundries, suppliers, and technology providers. Key focus areas included raw materials and ferro alloys, automotive and agriculture components, pump and valve industry, engineering castings, and foundry machinery. Networking and interactions enabled fruitful discussions with Egyptian counterparts.
