Exports: Mixed signals but strategic moves

While global trade remains challenging due to lingering protectionist policies and geopolitical tensions, there are encouraging signs. The Government is working on new bilateral trade agreements and export incentive schemes to mitigate disruptions caused by high tariffs in traditional Western markets. I urge members engaged in exports to explore diversification, participate in trade expos and leverage Government schemes for global outreach.

Financial Climate: A cautious optimism

December has brought a steady close to the financial quarter with notable developments. Interest rates remain stable; inflation is under control and industrial lending has become more accessible. The MSME sector, which forms the backbone of our industry, has seen enhanced access to credit through Government-backed loan schemes. Moreover, digitalisation of tax compliance and simplification of GST filings under GST 2.0 continue to make business operations more efficient for foundries.
